Veterinary Report

On Severe Trauma of a Dog (Earmark N 01743)

A dog (earmark N 01743) was received in the shelter of Georgian Society for the Protection and Safety of Animals – GSPSA on May 4, 2016. The dog is mixed breed, female, spayed, with golden coat, medium frame, with remodeled ears. The reason for receiving the dog in the shelter was severe trauma caused by a firearm. X-ray was taken at veterinary clinic Aibo at 13:00 p.m. on May 4, 2016.

Chief veterinarian of Georgian Society for the Protection and Safety of Animals – GSPSA Otar Davitishvili concluded the following based on examining the dog and x-ray:

The dog was shot at presumably in the morning of May 4, 2016. Pellet bullet was fired. The pellet is present in forelimbs and chest. As the pellet is abundant, the shooting should have been from close distance.

Due to the traumas the dog bleeds, limbs are swollen and the dog is in stress.

Urgent veterinary aid was provided. The wounds were treated and antibiotics shot. The dog is in the shelter – quarantine cage under surveillance of veterinarian and cynologist.

Minimum of one month is required for rehabilitation of the dog.
